Blood Donation Camp at DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya

National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya had organized blood donation camp on 11March 2022 in association with Jeevan Jyoti Blood bank. 62 people including students, teaching, non-teaching staff and many others donated the blood in the camp. Certificates, water bottles and refreshment had been given to the donors. 146 people came forward to test their Blood pressure, Hemoglobin, blood group etc. NSS volunteers assessed and helped in the camp.



Eye Check-up Camp at DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya

National Service Scheme (NSS) unit, Rotaract club and Extension Activity cell of Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya had organized an Eye Check-up camp in association with Mahatme Eye-bank & Eye Hospital. Camp facilitates free eye check-up, free sickle cell test, free specs. Camp witnessed an overwhelming response of 446 free eye check-ups out of which 18 patients in which cataract was detected and 3 with squinting will be operated free of cost at Mahatme hospital. 87 patients were scanned for sickle cell. 70 specs were distributed free of cost to the needy patients which were sponsored by Rotary club, CA Gaurav Kaushik and CA Jay Kaushik.
