Report

National Seminar on **"Revised Assessment Framework: Understandings and Challenges"** was Organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell ,Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur sponsored by NAAC.

We all are a part of the quality movement in Higher Education. We as academicians regularly organize workshops, conferences and seminars related to research and critical analysis on quality sustainability & enhancement at our workplace.

In the present seminar many salient points were discussed that included Internal and External quality evaluation processes, Promotion of quality culture, Development and implementation of quality sustenance initiatives, Promotion of quality in teachinglearning and research and Case studies of implemented quality practices in higher education.

He talked about the importance of NAAC for the improvement of the quality of educational institutions. He highlighted the revised accreditation framework. He emphasizes on 3Q's in quality: Quality Assurance, Quality Sustenance, Quality Enhancement. He discussed about Quality Indicators and explained in details about the brief classification of QI's in 3 parts i.e., 7 criteria, 34 key indicators and 96 metric. He discussed about all the seven criteria and gives some important tips for the improvement. At last, he answered the queries of the participants.





Technical Session I

The conference was organized by Department of Chemistry, Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur in Association with the Indian Society Of Analytical Scientists (ISAS), Nagpur Chapter. The objective of this conference was to bring together experts from academic institutions, Industries, and Research organizations for sharing their knowledge and research.

The **ICNHTCS-2022** is a forum to bring together researchers, scientists, and industry professionals to discuss innovative ideas and diverse topics on the next generation of chemical sciences and technologies. **ICNHTCS-2022**was joined by

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hundreds of delegates from about 7 countries including United States, Japan, South Africa, Austria, Israel, India, California etc. Hundreds of attendees, paper presenters, and students have benefited in many ways from this conference. Nearly 140 scientific papers were presented by authors. Selected presentations from Oral lectures as well as Posters were awarded.


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
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
