Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP)

Report

According to UGC guidelines on the promotion of academic integrity and prevention of plagiarism in HEI regulations 2018, our institution constituted the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) in August 2021. IAIP has a tenure of three years (2021-24). The panel contains two senior teachers of the institute and one member from outside the institution and one member from a Librarian nominated by the Head of HEI who is well-versed in anti-plagiarism tools.

This panel has conducted a program for degree college faculty members to be aware of the working and rights of IAIP. Dr. Shinkhede gives introductory remarks about the workings and constitution of IAIP. He also talked about plagiarism-checking software, tools, and systems. Dr. Pendsey, the Principal enlightened about the role of HEI in the mechanism through education and training to facilitate responsible conduct of research activities and promotion of academic integrity.

The awareness session was arranged with Dr. Gaurav Pendharkar, PDF at National Tsing Hua University, Taiwan working in nanofluids. He motivates the researchers about ethics in research for students and faculties. He also focused on the set-up of modules of coursework for PG and research students. Department of Zoology has conducted a one-day workshop on academic scientific writing where guests enlighten students about animal ethical protocols and content writing. Panel also motivate all faculty members and Post graduate students for keenly follow the disciplines and specificities in accordance with regulations for publications during the work.



WHEREAS

- 2) The INCUBEIN FOUNDATION has established incubation Center and utilizing the System and is offering to other Institutes to establish Innovation and incubation Sub-Center of INCUBEIN FOUNDATION
- The INCRUBEN is established as section 8 Company (Non-profit Organization) under companies act 2013 and has been funded by Maharashtra State Innovation Society (MSInS), Government of Maharashtra.
- c) The INCUBEIN is desirous to established the connections with all the affiliated colleges of University as well other institutes to promote the entrepreneurship among students and faculty through its expertise and to conduct the various training modules for upgrading the student.
- INCUBEIN is an initiative formed to promote the entrepreneurship, skill development and to create (8) employable human resource in different sectors.
- Incubein Sub-Center (Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya) is desirous of participating in Incubation/Innovation Program and has agreed to provide operational support for the various activities conducted by INCUBEIN for the benefit of students and faculty.

Role and Responsibilities

- INCUBEIN FOUNDATION and INCUBEIN SUB-CENTER (Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya) will share all the facilities available with their institutes free of cost or with minimal cost.
- 2. INCUBEIN will provide space to all its SUB-CENTER Startups for the research and development after the personal examination.
- 3. The final market ready product will be under the joint aegis of INCUBEIN and SUB-CENTER but the patent will be exclusively under the name of the person who has developed the product.
- 4. All technical support will be provided by the INCUBEIN incubation Center to the incubatee. INCUBEIN will also provide interns as per the project requirements with paid or unpaid internship.
- 5. A refresher training will be done by the INCUBEIN at the SUB-CENTERS once or twice a year as per the requirement of the Centres.
- 6. A monthly booklet will be issued for the SUB-CENTERS to let them know about the new MOUs done by the INCUBEIN and vice versa.
- 7. INCUBEIN will also provide mentors from time to time as per requirements to the SUB-CENTERS on the topics of their choice.
- 8. Technology sharing will be the key agenda for this agreement.
- 9. With the mutual understanding between both institutes extended agreement may be signed for the benefit of the students. INCUBEIN will provide all the necessary help and expertise available to SUB-CENTERS for their growth.
- 10. Sub-Centers will provide the faculty details and their expertise in respective fields to be provided to INCUBEIN.
- 11. Students information of each year to be share so that the information related to INCUBEIN and SUB-CENTERS circulated so that the information related to all the activities reach to each student.
- 12. To make INCUBEIN SUB-CENTER in-charge and his team along with active students to cater the need of students.
- 13. The details of Incubation team and their activities along with their difficulties should be provided to INCUBEIN so as to proper solution to be given to them
- 14. Various programs, seminars, workshops, Hackathons will be arranged. The SUB-CENTER Team will be responsible for promotion and execution of these programs.

- 15. Ideas nurture in the SUB-CENTERS with prototype may be forwarded to INCUBEIN for their further development and catalysis to make them successful entrepreneurs. In this case the incubate will be co-incubated in INCUBEIN and INCUBEIN SUB-CENTER.
- 16. Incubattee needs to sign the agreement with INCUBEIN FOUNDATION for coincubation. Without permission of INCUBEIN, Incubattee will not be able to use the name of INCUBEIN FOUNDATION or RTM Nagpur University.
- 17. Quarterly and yearly report to be submitted to INCUBEIN, failing in submission of reports may terminate this agreement.
- 18. If the idea is at initial stage and need all the developmental support the terms and conditions will be finalized at that time.
- 19. In case of any dispute arising in connection with this agreement or its interpretation or breach of any stipulations, except as hereinbefore provided, then the parties hereto shall endeavour to settle it through mutual discussions. If the disputes is not settled with mutual discussions, then any of the party or both parties, shall refer the matter to the Board of Directors, INCUBEIN FOUNDATION who shall decide the matter, at the earliest, and in any case within 45 (forty five) days from the date of any party approaching, with his written grievances to the Director, Incubein for referring the matter to the BOD, and whose decision shall be binding on the parties. If any of the party is not satisfied with the decision of the BOD or such named officer, or officer is unable to take up the matter or decide the matter, within said time or say within extended reasonable time, (if both parties agree for such extended time) then any of the aggrieved party, may resort to the arbitration, as hereinafter provided.
- 20. Any of the parties, being aggrieved by the final decision (or inaction to decide the matter in stipulated time or extended time) of Board of Directors of the INCUBEIN, for appointment an Arbitrator. The Board shall, having due regard to the nature of the dispute, amount involved, expertise required for resolving the dispute and other incidental issue, shall appoint a suitable person as an arbitrator. Such arbitrator can be in-house person or an outsider or can be an advocate or retired judicial officer or bureaucrat or Banker or IT expert, Financial expert or Company Law Expert or relevant expert in the field of the subject of dispute or any other person in the opinion of the Board who is a fit person to act as an arbitrator and expeditiously resolve the matter.
 - Arbitration Proceedings shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitrator shall be required to pass reasoned and speaking award. The Proceedings shall be in English and it shall be held at Nagpur. The cost of arbitration shall be shared equally by the parties.
- 21. The SUB-CENTERS shall not carry out any activity which is of unbecoming of the interest of the INCBUBEIN or RTMNU or which is prejudicial to the interest of the INCUBEIN in the opinion of INCBUEIN/RTMNU. The decision made by the INCBUEIN will final if any dispute arises.
- 22. The legal expenses for drawing up of agreements shall be borne by the SUB-CENTERS.

TERM AND TERMINATION

- This Agreement shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for One Year, ("Full Term").
- b) Sub-Centers will pay the processing fee of Rs. 1000/- (One thousand) by DD or Cheque payable to INCUBEIN FOUNDATION for establishment of Sub-Center.
- c) This agreement may be further extended by mutual consent in writing (Depending on the growth of Center reviewed by team of Incubein)

The agreement shall also stand terminated for any reason such as outcome of legal proceedings, act of state or similar such exigencies beyond the normal control of the parties or their authorized representative and specially stating the same to be amendment to this agreement.



- The aim is to help these startups grow and succeed by providing a nurturing environment and necessary support services


Activities for the session:


The session started with meeting of committee members to plan for the activities.

Number of students approached and after screening their registration details, 4-5 are selected for final mentorship and discussions.



A follow -up session was taken with the students. They were asked to explain their ideas and were encouraged to do literature surveys to explore more and write up a summary.





Scientific talk on Research in Life sciences

Topic:- "Central Regulation of Reproduction in Mammals"

Department of Zoology and Research and Development cell has organized a scientific talk for Post graduate and under graduate students to facilitate the new research horizon and to inculcate research temperament. Dr. Praful Singru, Associate professor, Biological Sciences, NISER, Bhubaneswar has delivered a talk on "Central regulation of reproduction in Mammals" on 19th October 2022. He has enlightened the students with basic concept of hormonal and neuropeptide regulation during reproductive phases in mammals and throw a focus on preoptic area and GnRH neuron working processes. He has carried regulation methods and observed that in contrast to mammals, birds have higher basal metabolic rate and undertake wide range of energy-demanding activities. As a consequence, food deprivation to birds, even for a short-period, poses major energy challenge. The energy-regulating hypothalamic homeostatic mechanisms, although extensively studied in mammals, are far from clear in the case of birds. We focus on the interplay between neuropeptide Y (NPY) and thyrotropin-releasing hormone (TRH), two of the most important hypothalamic signaling agents, in modulating the energy balance in a bird model, zebra finch, Taeniopygia guttata. TRH neurons were confined to a few nuclei in the preoptic area and hypothalamus, and fibers widely distributed. Majority of TRH neurons in the hypothalamic paraventricular nucleus (PVN) whose axons terminate in median eminence were contacted by NPY-containing axons. Dr. Yogesh Bhute was introduce and welcome Dr. Singru. About 62 students of PG and UG were preset for this lecture.




