In the spirit of intellectual cooperation, environment and forest protection, volunteering and wildlife forensics, **DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya Nagpur** agree to establish a program of exchange and collaboration on related matters of mutual interest:

- 1. The major thrust of this cooperation is to promote intellectual collaboration, volunteering, and imbibe within the students a sense of responsibility towards the environment.
- 2. To achieve the goals of this cooperation, both parties will:
  - a) Promote intellectual exchange of information and research by inviting officers (from Maharashtra Forest Department, Nagpur) and staff to trainee and students (from DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur) of the partner institution in various appropriate activities;

The faculty members of the **Department of Botany** and students of **DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur** may involve in the activities and research programmes of forest development which will be organised by Maharashtra Forest Department, Nagpur subject to mutual convenience;

- c) Maharashtra Forest Department, Nagpur has to permit students and staff of DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur to explore forest areas for biodiversity conservation and for study tours under their supervision;
- d) Collaboratively organise activities like expert talks, seminars, workshops, various competitions and trainings for students and citizens, whenever possible;
- e) Guidance and lectures by forest officials to students for UPSC and MPSC forest services' examinations and other employment avenues in forest department;
- f) Information sharing from expert staff of Department of Botany, DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur to the trainee/ appropriate staff of Maharashtra Forest Department, Nagpur;

- g) Activities will be conducted to create awareness among citizens about the environment protection and biodiversity conservation.
- h) **DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya** Nagpur will participate in conducting collaborative research in relation with Wildlife Flora conservation.
- As per National Education Policy of India 2020 (NEP 2020), Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), Government of India provided opportunities for field project and internships and on job training as per University/UGC as part of a holistic education; by mutual understanding students will work as an intern in conservation of wildlife flora and fauna.
- 3. Prior to the initiation of any event, the specific terms of cooperation and exchange (TOC) for that event will be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible representatives of both parties.
- 4. Both parties understand that there will be no any financial implications between DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur and Maharashtra Forest Department, Nagpur.
- 5. DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur shall not seek any finance from MFD, Nagpur for any activity (except staff and/ or students engaged in projects given by MFD, Nagpur [if applicable]). MFD, Nagpur shall not seek any finances from DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur for exploration of forest areas, study tours, publication of research articles in various research journals, magazines, and any other means.

6. Expert staff of Department of Botany, DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur will not charge any fees for conduction of any lectures to the trainee/ appropriate staff of MFD, Nagpur; as well as MFD, Nagpur will not charge any fees of resource persons for conduction of classes, lectures and for providing study material to students.

7. Both the parties signing this MoU shall use their names, logos, and vision statements to the other party for the sake of advertisement or proliferation of activities otherwise indicated.

- 8. Each Party agrees to release and hold the other harmless from and against any claims, damages, liability, or costs, to the extent such claims damages, liability or costs do not arise from the negligent or wilful acts or any of its agents or employees in connection with their respective performance under this MoU.
- Both parties agree that while implementing this MoU, they will not engage in unlawful discrimination on the grounds of race, gender, sexual orientation, age, religion, social class, national or ethnic origin or disability.
- 10. Amendments to this MoU may be made at any time after consultation and agreement between both the parties. Any such amendment must be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 11. This MoU will remain in force for a period of 5 (five) years from the date it is fully executed or can be extended for further years. The MoU can also be suitably modified, as agreed to by both the parties, to reflect an increased scope, nature of engagement/activities including financial commitments, if any.
- 12. Prior to the expiration date, the MoU may be reviewed for possible renewal for a further 5 Years period. In addition, either party may terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration by providing the other with six months' prior written notice. However, for early termination of MoU, all the ongoing activities will continue till completion of commitments and obligations of the activity.
- 13. Any dispute arising out of this MoU will be settled by mutual negotiations between the two parties only. Both the party have right to end the agreement any time without any financial implication. And whenever a dispute arises regarding the agreement, the decision of MFD Nagpur will be final. Also the jurisdiction will be Nagpur.

 This MoU has been executed in two originals; one of these has been retained by MFD, Nagpur and the other by DRB Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur.
