During the survey two teams of students were formed. Team A having 09 students and Team B having 09 students. Students visited various departments like Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Physics, Girls common room, Electronics, Roof top tanks, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Boys common room, Principal's chamber, Garden, Quadrangle drinking water machine, Canteen, Computer science, Mathematics and Language department. Student carried out detailed survey. In the survey it is observed that 15 out of 17 taps in girls' common room were leaking, it is a matter of concern. The detailed report is submitted to principal and requested to principal to make necessary action for repairing of all leaking taps in our college premises.
